

RESULTS OF THE 3rd NAERIC BARRELS OF CASH PROSPECT SALE

The third annual NAERIC Barrels of Cash Prospect Sale was held in conjunction with the Wheat City Stampede on Friday, October 22, 2010, at the Keystone Centre, Brandon, Manitoba. A good crowd was on hand and foals sold to Ontario, Saskatchewan and Manitoba.

The high seller was Lot #39, **BDB Famous Cejay** that sold for \$4,100 to Dr. Everett More, Virden, MB. The filly was consigned by Tom & Sharlene Bennie, B Double Bar Ranch, Waskada, Manitoba. She was sired by **Mac N Fame**, an earner of \$30,000 with his Race Register Of Merit, and a son of the leading barrel racing sire **Dash Ta Fame** whose offspring earnings are in excess of 15 Million. Her dam was **Dashing Hot Cejay**, a grand-daughter of **Dash For Cash** and **Kitaman**.

There were 37 lots on offer in 2010, and the average was \$795. Foals selling in the NAERIC Barrels of Cash are eligible for a \$9000.00 stake race in 2015, their five year old year. The stake is open to all ages and genders of riders.
